WHAT DOES IT COST TO SHOOT AT THE ORLANDO GUN CLUB?

That depends of you are shooting a shooting package or shooting on an a la carte basis...

SHOOTING PACKAGES - ALL INCLUSIVE SHOOTING EVENTS

OGC shooting packages offer an all-inclusive shooting experience at a low flat fee per person! Shooting packages must be booked & pre-paid online.

A LA CARTE SHOOTING - PAY AS YOU GO

How much will this cost? That's kind of like calling a restaurant and asking how much will by dinner be? It all depends on what you order! OGC A La Carte fees are as follows:

\$12.95 per person
\$15.95 per person

\$19.95 per group

• Range Assistance \$19.95 per group (Not Required but recommended for first timers)

• Targets \$1.50 to \$2.00 each

• Ammunition \$6.99 to \$34.99 per box (Ammunition prices vary depending on the caliber)

As a guide, typically people spend between \$50.00 and \$80.00 per person depending on how much they shoot.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

The minimum age to be on any of our ranges is 12 years old

Anyone under the age of 21 (who does not intend to shoot their own, legally owned firearm at the OGC) must be accompanied by a parent. Again, **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT** (Parents only – No legal guardians, no exceptions).

GROUP SIZE LIMITS

Groups larger than 4 shooters are **REQUIRED** to setup a reservation/shooting package on our website: https://www.orlandogun-club.com/events/. We reserve the right to turn large groups away due to range capacity and safety concerns.

ID REQUIREMENTS

Anyone who wants to shoot at The Orlando Gun Club <u>MUST</u>have an original valid government issued ID (Passport, Driver's License, etc.). Copies of Passports or Drivers licenses are not acceptable.

REQUIRED ATTIRE

- No open toes shoes (flips-flops and/or sandals) allowed
- No low-cut tops allowed

GUN RENTAL REQUIREMENTS

- For safety reasons, we use the buddy system here at The Orlando Gun Club. We require there are:
 (2) people 21 years of age or older in your party to rent firearms. Yes, you read it correctly, to rent a gun at The Orlando Gun Club, you must have (2) people 21 years of age or older.
- Gun rentals stop daily 90 minutes before we close.

US LAW REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TOURISTS, FIREARMS & RESTRICTIONS

In compliance with US Federal law <u>only international tourists visiting the US under the Visa Waiver Program may legally purchase ammunition / shoot at The Orlando Gun Club (without violating Federal Law)</u>. Permitted tourist must be from one of the following countries:

In addition to being from one of these countries **you must also be visiting using the Visa Waiver Program.** For more information on the Visa Waiver Program and to verify if you will be visiting the United State under the Visa Waiver Program, please review all of the information on the following website: www.travel.state.gov/content/visas/english/visit/visa-waiver-program.html.

We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone who cannot provide a copy of their ESTA paperwork.

If you are not here under the Visa Waiver Program unfortunately it is a violation of US Federal Law for you to shoot at The Orlando Gun Club. US Federal Law does not allow anyone visiting on a non-immigrant visa to purchase or possess firearms or ammunition.

18 US Code 922 - Unlawful Acts (d) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or otherwise dispose of any firearm or ammunition to any person knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that such person—(5) who, being an alien—(B) except as provided in subsection (y)(2), has been admitted to the United States under a nonimmigrant visa (as that term is defined in section 101(a) (26) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 (a)(26)));
